



# Berwick Heritage Walk Map



- Walk direction (approx. 3 kms)
- Detour
- Heritage markers
- View
- Car park areas
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times

Please note that the Berwick area is quite steep and many parts of the walk involve a moderate gradient or incline. The length of the walk is estimated to be approximately 3 kilometres.

Car park areas are marked on the map for those who may choose to drive to certain points on the tour and then walk around the vicinity.

Please note that many of the historical sites included in this walk are private property.

### Heritage Markers

Located within the High Street shopping precinct are 3 Heritage Markers depicting life in Berwick since the early 1800's.

- Heritage Marker : Located in the grassed centre median strip directly opposite the Berwick Mechanics Institute/Library, includes details about Berwick Inn, Edwin Flack, Berwick Mechanics Institute & War Memorial
- Heritage Marker : Located out the front of the old Court House (South-east corner of Gloucester Avenue and High Street), explains about Berwick Court House and Post Office
- Heritage Marker : Beside the walkway near Gloucester Avenue traffic lights opposite the comfort station, under the large Moreton Bay Fig tree, lists information about Wilson Botanic Park and Berwick in general
